The Stafford 14-19 Partnership

In Stafford, post-16 students wishing to continue their education in a school setting, close to home, can do so based at one of our partner school's Sixth Forms. However, you are not restricted to courses offered solely at that school, instead, you have the opportunity to access courses offered at our other four Sixth Forms. For example:

You may choose to be based at Blessed William Howard Catholic High School and study certain subjects there, but you may wish to combine those with an A Level which is offered at a different partner school e.g. Sir Graham Balfour School/The Weston Road Academy/King Edward VI High School or Stafford Manor High School.

Pathways

We can offer you the opportunity to follow a purely academic route (A Levels only) or to opt for vocational qualifications (BTECs). Alternatively, you may decide to study a mixture of both.


Why choose a Stafford 14-19 Partnership Sixth Form?

Entry Criteria

The Sixth Form entry criteria vary according to the type of pathway you wish to follow:

A Level Pathway

You need GCSEs in at least **seven** different subjects at grade 9-4 (including English and mathematics).

To study other subjects already taken at GCSE you need to achieve at least a grade 5 or above in that subject.

BTEC Pathway

You need GCSEs in at least **five** different subjects at grade 9-4 (including English and mathematics).

You need a 5 in the subject to be studied or in a subject relating to the one to be studied.

Mixed Pathway

You will be able to select a combination of BTEC and A Level courses.

Entry criteria for a mixed pathway can be discussed with your Head of Sixth Form.

Whichever pathway you would like to take, you will need to discuss this with your Head of Sixth Form who will advise you on your choices.

How to Apply to Our Sixth Form

All Sixth Forms in the Stafford 14-19 Partnership use Google Forms for applications.

Your school will guide you through the process and may require you to complete your application during personal meetings with tutors.

Please note, you cannot choose more than one subject from each block and should double check BTECs as they may need to be chosen across two blocks.
